ARTICLE I
Stores, Shops and Restaurants

- § 82-1. License required; inspection.

It shall be unlawful to maintain or operate any place of business where food or beverages are sold for human consumption or where clothing or other materials and fabrics are cleaned or washed unless the owner or operator thereof shall first procure a license which may be issued by the Clerk only after an inspection of the premises and a determination by him that the premises are clean and sanitary and conform to proper health and safety standards.

- § 82-2. Adult attendant required.

No place of business so licensed shall be operated or open to the public without an adult attendant present at all times.

§ 82-3. Stores, restaurants, etc.

All grocery stores, department stores, variety stores, restaurants, lunch rooms, drugstores and other places of business, except garage and gasoline filling stations, shall close and discontinue all business at 12:00 midnight and shall remain closed until 5:00 a.m.

ARTICLE III

Conduct of Trade on Independence and Memorial Days

§ 82-4. Hours of sales prohibited; exceptions.

The conduct of all trades and manufacturers and all manner of public selling or offering for sale of property and services between 12:00 midnight and 12:00 noon on the days on which Independence Day and Memorial Day are celebrated is hereby prohibited except the following:

- A. The sale of prepared food and beverage at restaurants, lunch rooms, ice cream parlors and bakeries, and the sale of beverages at establishments whose hours of business are regulated by state law;
- B. The sale of gasoline and petroleum and other products and services customarily sold at garages and gasoline filling stations;
- C. The sale of drugs, medicines and other items at drugstores; and
- D. The sale of newspapers, books and other items customarily sold in news stores.

§ 82-5. Penalties for offenses.

The penalties and other remedies specified in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article III, General Penalty, of the Code shall apply to a violation of this article.
