Mission Statement

The Village of Pelham Manor Police Department is a professionally staffed Law Enforcement Agency dedicated to providing optimal services for all village residents and visitors. There are 27 well trained professional officers. The Police Department provides prompt and courteous service for a wide variety of situations. We urge our residents to play an active role in crime prevention by telephoning our Police (914 738-1000) immediately upon your observing any type of suspicious activity or behavior. Even if your call should be unfounded our police would rather respond to all such calls than allow a crime to occur. The average police response time to a call is under two minutes.

Police Department Staff

The department has 27 dedicated Police Officers, staffs a Chief of Police, one Lieutenant, two Detectives, six uniformed patrol Sergeants and 17 Patrolmen. All officers are certified in CPR through the American Red Cross and certified by the American Heart Association in the use of Automated External Defibrillators (AED's). Each officer is thoroughly trained in all phases of first aid and attends frequent refresher courses. Also, every patrol vehicle is equipped with an oxygen unit and AED's.

False Alarms

There are penalties for false alarms:

If you have a false alarm you should immediately notify the police department to avoid these penalties.

1st two alarms within 3 months are no charge.
3 false alarms within three consecutive months \$50.00
Additional false alarms within consecutive month will be \$100.00 each.

Vehicle Safety

Safeguarding one's vehicle is another aspect of preventive enforcement which many people too often take for granted. Remember to lock you vehicle and set the alarm if applicable.

Dark House Notification

If you plan on being away or on vacation and you would like the Police Department to check on your home in your absence you can call 914 738-1000.and relay the information to the desk officer.

House Numbers

Every residence or place of business is required to be numbered and to have its number attached to the front of the building and visible. Building numbering is critically important in an emergency. It can save police, fire and ambulance personnel valuable time in responding to an emergency.

Overnight Parking

There is prohibited parking in the village between the hours of 2:00AM – 7:00AM. If you have a guest or need to park your car on the street due to your driveway being obstructed you may request permission by calling Police Headquarters 914 738-1000, before, 2:00AM. Have your vehicle plate number, description and location when speaking with Police Desk officer. In the event you need to request long term overnight parking, you can speak with the Police Lieutenant for permission.
