MINUTES

The Mayor asked if there were any comments or questions on the March 23, 2012 minutes. There were no comments or questions.

After discussion and upon motion duly made and seconded, it was unanimously

RESOLVED, That the minutes from March 23, 2012 be and hereby are approved.

REPORTS

Fire Commissioner Sellier discussed the report with Chief Ruggiero. The Commissioner said that it had seemed like it had been a quiet month.

Chief Ruggiero said that there had been some structural fires. La Fontanella Restaurant, in Pelham, had a structure fire in the basement. He noted that Greenville Fire Department need to cover a fire in Greenburgh or Fairview. Pelham Manor does not usually travel that far but the Town of Eastchester's Tower Ladder truck was out of service and Pelham Manor was the municipality that was called to provide the Tower Ladder. The Village of Larchmont covered for the Village of Pelham Manor. He said that mutual aid has the domino effect.

Commissioner Sellier said that department attendance was good. It was noted that there was one fire loss in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars.

The Board thanked the Chief for his report.

The Mayor asked if there were comments or questions on the Village Clerk's report.

There were no comments or questions.
