Mayor Sellier opened the Public Hearing on the Tentative Budget for 2013-2014. He asked if there were any comments on the Budget.

Trustee Schwarzfeld said that once again the Village Manager has done a remarkable job considering the constraints.

The Mayor commented that every municipality has the same issues. The pension system bill of one million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars is up a few hundred thousand dollars. This problem will get worse until Albany does something about it. With the tax cap and the revenues that go to pay for the pension costs it is hard to maintain a level of services expected by our residents.

Trustee Vandenberg said that this was a remarkable job. The job of putting the budget together and keeping it within the tax cap present greater and greater pressures every year.

The Mayor opened the hearing to public comment.
