Under the general supervision of the Police Department, the position of school crossing guard is part-time employment at an assigned post that comes with a personal sense of job satisfaction as you safeguard school children walking across busy intersections on their way to and from school.

A School Crossing Guard requires vigilance in directing and protecting children and is rewarded with an exceptional opportunity to serve your community.

Pay & Schedule

\$29.25 per hour; uniforms will be provided.

11:30AM – 01:00PM

02:15PM – 03:30PM

**Specific post times may vary*

Examples of Work

- Stops traffic at crosswalks near school for the safety of school children only;
- Assists children crossing street going to and returning from school;
- Instructs younger children in the precautions to be taken when crossing the street.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Attributes

Ability to be firm yet courteous with the public; ability to get along well with children; ability to think and act quickly in emergencies; good powers of observation; dependability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position; must have reliable transportation

Special Notes

A School Crossing Guard is not a member of the uniformed Police Department of a municipality and does not perform police duties. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
